- -Teacher led
- -20 hours long
- -Orientation & Assessment course
- -Uses a variety of tools

Smarter/Measure (feedback on skills areas, personal attributes, learning styles, typing speed & accuracy)

TypeFocus (career clarification)

ITP development (goal setting & learner plan development)



Incorporates in depth assessment, goal setting, career clarification learning how to be a successful online learner and development of an ITP by the learner.
