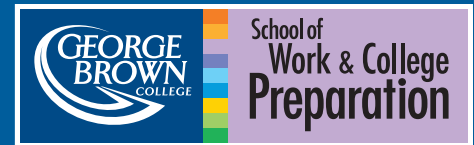


# Welcome to Deaf Learn Now!

# ONLINE MATH, ENGLISH AND INDEPENDENCE COURSES

## for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Adults



*Earn credits for post-secondary, prepare for employment and learn new skills*

Deaf Learn Now is a tuition-free online program open to all Deaf, Deaf-Blind and Hard of Hearing adults in Ontario.

Learners can register for Deaf Learn Now any time!



### 2016-17 COURSE OFFERINGS

#### WELCOME TO DEAF LEARN NOW. INTRODUCTION TO PROGRAM

Welcome to Deaf Learn Now: This is a short and mandatory course for all learners joining Deaf Learn Now. Learn how to use the site, work with your teachers, and get the most from your online learning experience

#### DEAF CULTURE

Deaf studies: Each course lasts 6 weeks, new intake every 2 months.

- » Deaf Studies Part 1: Learn about Deaf history, people and events.
- » Deaf Studies Part 2: A special course looking at current/recent Deaf events, issues and people.
- » Deaf Studies Part 3: A look at the creative side of Deaf culture!
- » Deaf Studies Part 4: A study of Deaf athletes and sports organizations in Ontario and around the world.

#### MATH

- » Math – Time & Fractions (level 1): A short course teaching fraction basics and time calculations. Start any time!
- » **NEW! Survivor Math:** A video game based short course which teaches foundational

math skills (whole number operations, fractions, time and money management). Start any time!

- » **NEW! ACE Mathematics:** 15 week course with online teacher, granting students an ACE Math credit (Grade 12 equivalent) which they can use to apply to Ontario College post-secondary programs. Topics begin with Whole Number Operations and go to Advanced Algebra. Potential students must meet with Deaf Learn Now staff to register. **Class start dates:** September, January, May, registration open until first class dates.
- » Writing the Date: Short course. Start any time!

#### COMMUNICATIONS COURSES

- » Media Literacy: Media is everywhere! This short course will explore different types of media, advertising techniques, and how media affects our lives everyday. Start any time!
- » **NEW! ACE Communications:** Develop strong reading, research and writing skills, while collaboratively writing articles for an online magazine. This 15 week course with online teacher grants students an ACE Credit (Grade 12 equivalent) after successful completion of the course. Potential students must

meet with Deaf Learn Now staff to register. **Class start dates:** September, January, May, registration open until first class dates.

#### PROFESSIONAL COMMUNICATIONS FOR SCHOOL, LIFE + WORK

Better email course (2 courses)

- » Part 1: Simple tips that will help you write clear and better e-mails! Start any time!
- » Part 2: Learn how to write formal e-mails and group mailing procedures. Start any time!

#### LIFE & INDEPENDENCE

- » G1 - Driver's Licence (part 1): A clear and visual way to learn and practice for your G1 test. Start any time!
- » G1 - Driver's Licence (part 2): A continuation of the G1 - Driver's Licence (part 1) course. Note: Start date July 2016. Start any time!
- » Under the Sink: A home safety course teaching learners about the potential dangers in household detergents and chemicals. Start any time!
- » **NEW! WHMIS Course:** Earn your WHMIS Certificate through George Brown College by completing this online safety course. **Course start date:** Summer 2016 - Start any time!
