## Skills for Success Funding for LBS - Phase 1 & 2

In Fall 2022, the Ontario Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development (MLITSD) received funding from the federal government's "Skills for Success" program.

(Employment and Social Development Canada - ESDC)

Phase 1: 2022-23

Phase 2: 2023-24









## Phase 1

SFS funding for LBS was related to these 5 themes:

### Apprenticeship Integration

Better Jobs Ontario (BJO) Integration

Expanding and Enhancing Digital Delivery

Supporting Underrepresented Groups

Workplace Literacy









## In November 2022 for Phase 1:

10 provincial LBS support organizations received funding for SFS resource development

16 LBS regional networks received SFS to conduct LBS community integration activities related to the SFS themes

### **SFS Resource Development**

In Phase 1, (2022-23) almost 200 curriculum resources were developed by the provincial LBS support organizations

(In addition, 39 e-Channelspecific resources were also developed) Expanding and Enhancing Digital Delivery (37)

Supporting Apprentices (48)

Supporting Underrepresented Groups (52)

Workplace Literacy (20)









In phase 2 (2023-24), the provincial LBS support orgs were again invited to apply for SFS curriculum resource development funds

120+ resources were developed in phase 2

(\*27 e-Channel specific resources were developed in phase 2 under the Digital Delivery theme) Expanding and Enhancing Digital Delivery (\*27)

Supporting Apprentices (39)

Supporting Underrepresented Groups (42)

Workplace Literacy (37)









## What else happened in <a href="Phase 2">Phase 2</a> ?

- a) The 16 LBS regional networks were invited to apply for community integration projects under four of the SFS themes:
  - Supporting Apprenticeship
  - Supporting Underrepresented Groups
  - Supporting Better Jobs Ontario
  - Workplace Delivery

## What else happened in Phase 2?

- b) LBS service providers were invited to apply for SFS service delivery pilots under three of the SFS themes
  - Supporting Underrepresented Groups
  - Supporting Better Jobs Ontario
  - Workplace Literacy

Approximately 120 SFS service delivery pilots were funded Of those, over 70 were in the **Supporting Underrepresented Groups** theme

Applying for Phase 2 funding was voluntary and was done through the 2023-24 LBS business planning process

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





## SKILLSFORSUCCESS INITIATIVES SERVICE DELIVERY PILOTS 2023/24 CASE STUDY OVERVIEW

From 2022 to 2024, Ontario's Literacy and Basic Skills (LBS) program received federal funding to undertake projects in support of Canada's Skills for Success (SFS) framework.

Resource development and/or service delivery pilots were funded under five initiatives:

- · Supporting Underrepresented Groups;
- · Supporting Apprenticeship Integration;
- · Supporting Better Jobs Ontario Integration;
- · Workplace Literacy; and
- Expanding and Enhancing Digital Delivery.

Projects were designed in accordance with the Ontario Adult Literacy Curriculum Framework (OALCF).

#### The goals of SFS initiatives are:

- to support ongoing LBS program development objectives by building capacity across cultural streams and delivery sectors;
- to strengthen LBS employment and apprenticeship outcomes;
- to integrate LBS services into the broader workforce development system; and
- to enhance and expand blended and fully distance learning opportunities.









- 17 SFS case studies & success stories were contributed by LBS sites who delivered a SFS delivery pilot in 23-24
- Case studies from 3 SFS themes are included: Better Jobs Ontario, Underrepresented Groups & Workplace




