








Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs










Stages of Change








WE ARE ALL MOTIVATED FOR SOMETHING

- Everyone is motivated for something.
- When learners/clients aren't motivated for the same thing that we are, we say, "They just aren't motivated."
- We move toward things we value.
- Find out what the person is motivated for.












Motivation

Goal:

The person makes the argument for change, not you

Strategy: connect the goal to the values of your learner by asking open ended powerful coaching questions that evoke change talk.











A Motivational Coach Approach ©

- Motivation factors are diverse & personal
- Effective coaching = adapting, not imposing
- Meeting clients where they truly are builds trust and engagement
- A coach approach vs fix it approach is the key ingredient.

- **Ask**, don't assume **curiosity** moves us out of judgement
- **Listen** for motivating factors and then reframe using their motivational language
- Recognize and align the supports with what gives them resonance and energy.
- Acknowledge & Champion!!
